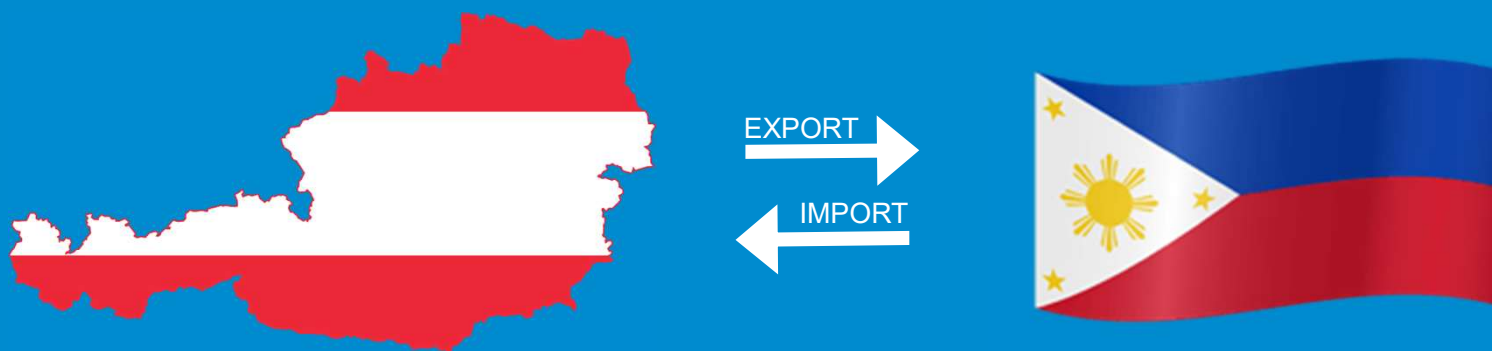

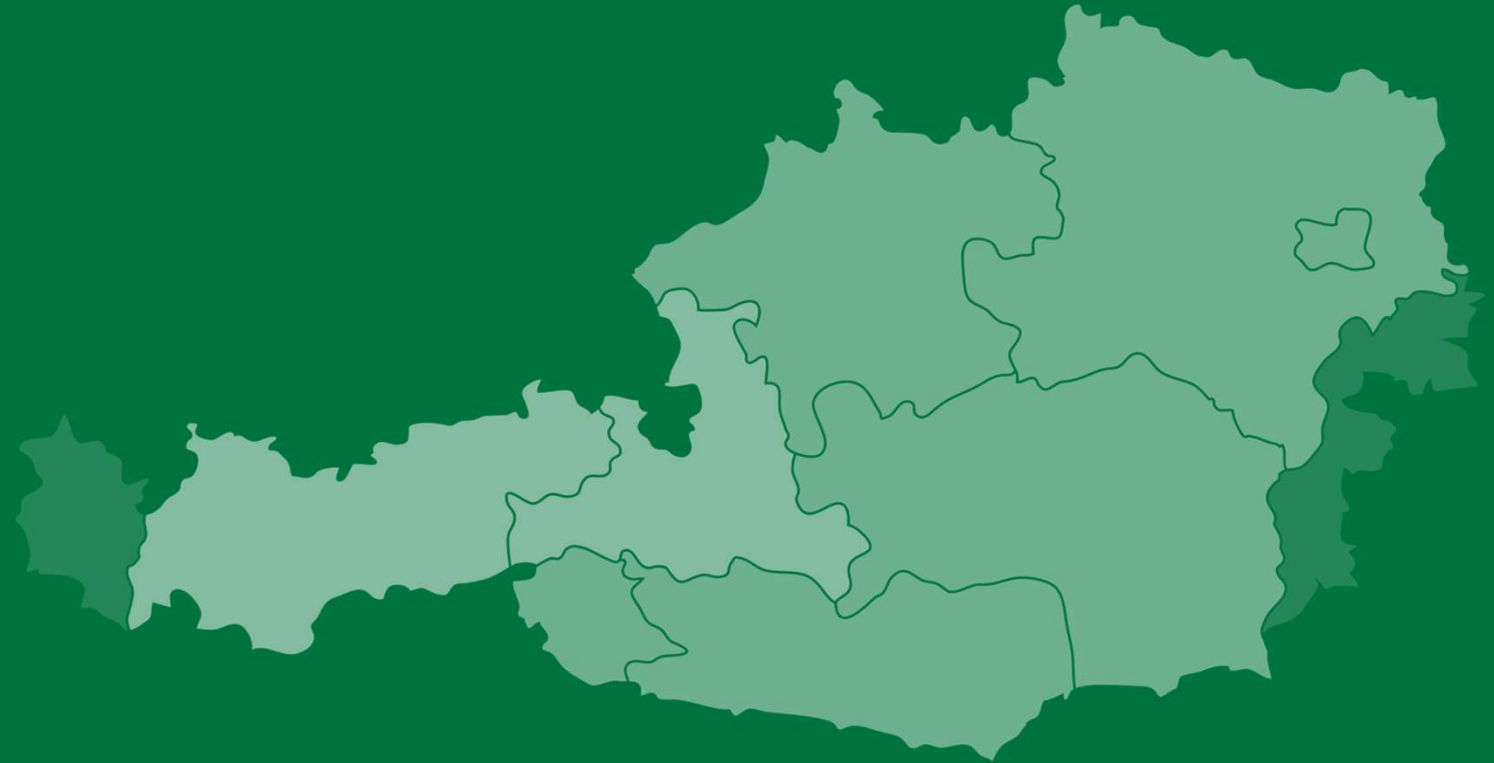

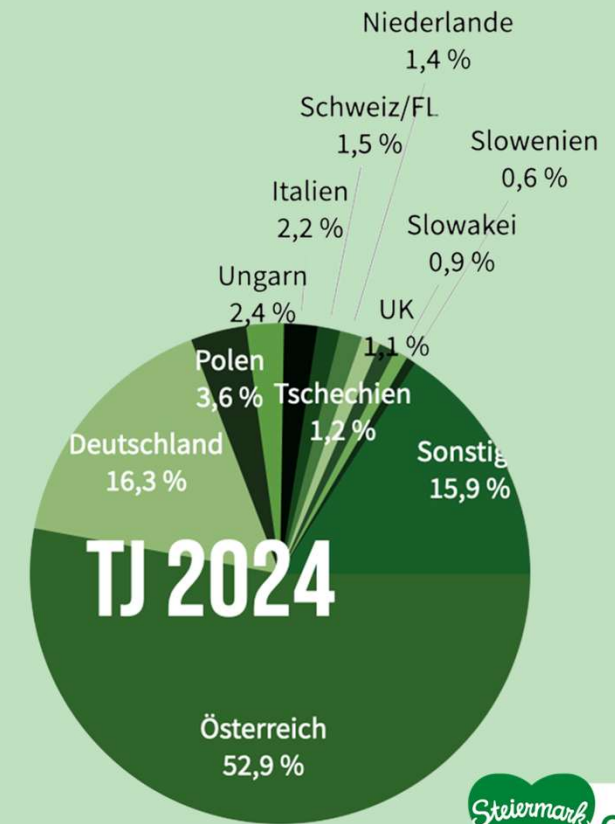

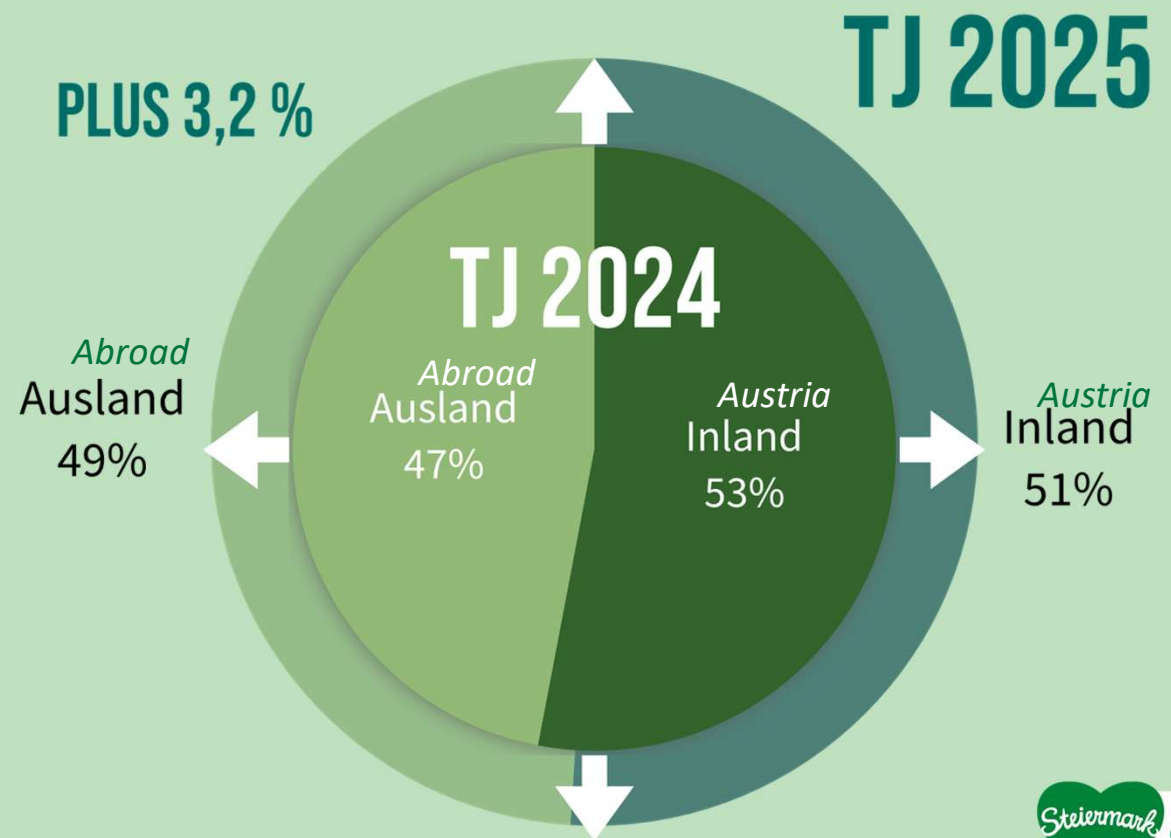

by 11.4%



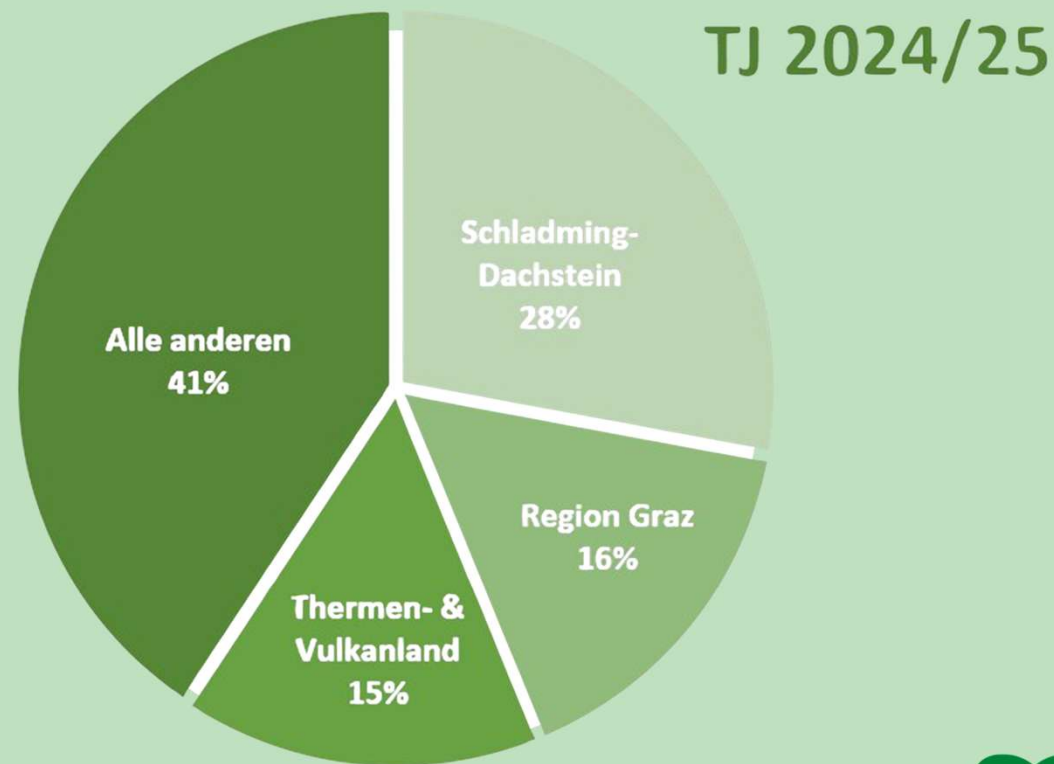

SIMPLIFIED PROCEDURES IN HIRING FILIPINOS FROM THE PHILIPPINES



First Step

Employer informs PRA of its manpower requirements.

Second Step

PRA guides Employer about the legal migration procedures and DMW - MWO documentary requirements involving Filipino workers.

Third Step

Employer and PRA sign a Recruitment or Service Agreement, containing their obligations including fees and charges.

Fourth Step

After DMW procedures are completed, PRA performs documentation processing and other services.

Fifth Step

The workers are deployed to jobsite, In accordance with Employer's timeline.

Fifth Step

The PRA performs post-deployment services, by maintaining communication with Employer and the deployed worker.

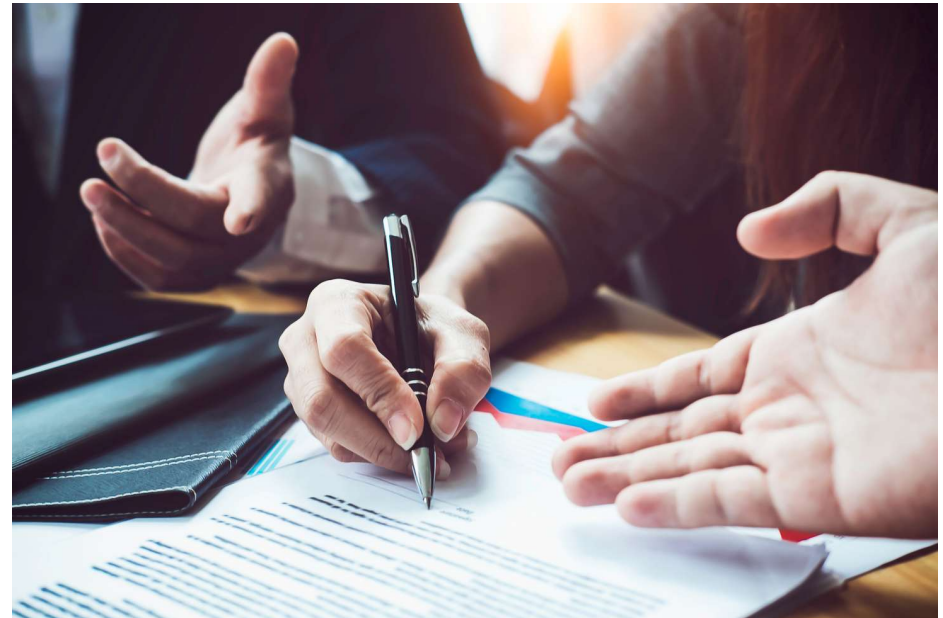


SERVICE FEES NEGOTIATION

The amount and payment terms for Service fees of the PRA, are to be “negotiated” between Employer and the licensed PRA

The basis for negotiation are as follows:

- (1) volume of manpower requirements
- (2) Qualifications of workers required
 - Either “easy-to-find” or “hard-to-find” candidates
- (3) Recruitment efforts needed :
 - More efforts: Agency must find qualified candidates
 - Less/No efforts: Agency need NOT find new candidates when workers have been pre-appointed/nominated by Employer and ready for endorsement to Sending Organization
- (4) The relationship between Employer and Agency
- (5) Labor laws, rules and practices in relation to collection of placement fees.



SERVICE FEES NEGOTIATION

Reminder:

Austria and Lithuania are NON-FEE CHARGING COUNTRIES.



EMPLOYER AND PRA TOGETHER, SHOULD:

- Ensure that approved Employment Contract of worker is faithfully implemented in the jobsite
- Deployed worker's condition is monitored and significant developments (e.g. hospitalization; separation from company; contract completion; repatriation to Philippines; death), are reported to concerned labor authorities.

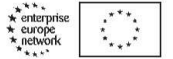

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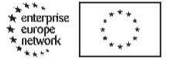
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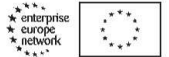
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
